DECLARATION

Do hereby declare as follows that:

- 1. I have full knowledge of the anti-littering campaign implemented by the EPA ("Eastern Province Athletics") and support it;
- 2. I will adhere to Rule 28 of ASA ("Athletics South Africa") Rules, which I have read and fully understand;
- 3. Should I fail to comply with the provisions of Rule 28 at any race I understand that I will be held accountable and the following sanctions will or can be imposed against me:
 - 3.1 First offence: verbal warning (yellow card);
 - 3.2 Second Offence: disqualification from the race in which I committed the offence;
 - 3.3 Continued Offences will be dealt with at a disciplinary hearing which will be held at EPA which may result in the following sanctions:
 - 3.3.1 suspension from participating in any future races in the EPA jurisdiction; or
 - 3.3.2 I may be required to work at a water station for one race and only once completed, will my suspension be lifted to be able to participate in future races;

For ease of reference of Rule 28:

- Littering is the act of disposing any waste item unless disposed in an appropriate receptacle (28.1)
- ASA may impose fines on race organisers (28.3)
- Littering is categorised as (28.4)
 - Unintentional: When a runner intends to throw waste in a bin and misses
 - Intentional: When a runner discards waste where there is no bin in the area
- IAAF ("International Association of Athletics Federations") rule 125 allows referees, where blatant intentional littering to take serious action against an athlete (28.5)
